## American Whiskeys

### Pappy Van Winkle 20 yr.

Lavish aromas of caramelized pecans, chocolate fudge, and rich baking spices. A bold, powerful entry leads to a dryish full body of intense dried fruits, buttery praline, vibrant baking spices. Finishes with a seemingly endless and evolving cascade that introduces notes of cigar box, sweet tobacco, leather, dried tangerine, and so on... In short, a monumental bourbon.

Shot 10 Neat 19 Rocks 24

### Bernheim Straight Wheat Whiskey

Brilliant copper color. Sweet toffee, roasted nut, and brown spice aromas are inviting. A silky entry leads to a very supple, dryish medium-to-full body of rich caramelized nut and creme brulee flavors. Finishes with a long, warming fade of dark caramel, stony minerality, and tingling peppery spice. A wonderfully delicious and dangerously drinkable whiskey with instant appeal to lovers of fine bourbon.

Shot 7 Neat 14 Rocks 19

### Blanton's

Deep amber color. Rich aromas of baking spice, vanilla cream, and caramelized nuts. A vibrant, supple entry leads to a dryish medium-full body of honeyed toast, dried fruits, peppery spice, toffee and charred nuts. Finishes with a honeyed grain, limestone, and deep spice fade. An elegant yet gutsy whiskey

Shot 8 Neat 16 Rocks 20

### Buffalo Trace

Deep amber color. Elegant aromas of buttery caramel, toasted nuts, and brown spices. A silky, supple entry leads to a dry-yet-fruity medium-full body of honeyed toasted cornbread toast, intense brown spices, and pralines. Finishes with a long, layered fade of vanilla, caramel, cinnamon spice, and minerals. Impressive toasted barrel character shines through

Shot 4 Neat 8 Rocks 11

### Eagle Rare Single Barrel

Rich amber color. Sweet dried orange peel, spicy honey, coconut fruit, and a touch of shellac. A fresh, smooth entry leads to an off-dry, rich full-bodied palate with even toffee, macerated cherry, nut, and brown spice flavors. Finishes with a sweet spicy fade of dried fruits, vanilla and oak. Great balance and vitality.

Shot 5 Neat 10 Rocks 14

### Bulleit

Deep amber color. Highly polished aromas of creamy vanilla, pickling spices, and buttery pralines. A delicate, silky entry leads to a dry-yet-fruity medium-to-full body of honeyed grain, sweet baking spice, vanilla bean, and pralines. Finishes with a long, rich fruity caramel, peppery spice and mineral accented fade. A elegant sipping or mixing bourbon.

Shot 5 Neat 10 Rocks 14

### Knob Creek

Deep amber color. Vanilla and caramel fudge, licorice, peanut, and wet wood aromas. a round entry leads to a smooth dryish medium-full to-bodied palate with brown sugar, spicy rye, licorice and brown spice flavors. Finishes with a somewhat lean and tannic wood spice fade. Develops nicely with a little water—a good one to work on and savor over time.

Shot 5 Neat 10 Rocks 14

### Woodford Reserve

Deep amber color. Spicy charred oak, sweet toffee, and pepper aromas. A rich entry leads to a dryish medium-to full-bodied palate with toffee, mocha, and white pepper flavors with a pronounced copper tang. Finishes with a sweet, charred barrel, brown, and metallic fade. An aggressive and spicy bourbon that will work nicely in a bourbon peach tea cocktail.

Shot 5 Neat 10 Rocks 14

### Bakers

Rich amber color. Sweet, buttery caramel, stone fruit, and nut aromas. A rich entry leads to a spicy, off-dry full-bodied palate with vibrant toffee, brown spice, and white pepper flavors. Finishes with a lingering wave of sweet vanilla and wood spice. Very even and straightforward. Try with a touch of water.

Shot 6 Neat 12 Rocks 17

### Bookers

Rich copper color. Toffee and earthy, oily roasted peanut aromas. A rich entry leads to a vibrant off-dry full-bodied palate with toasted coconut, toffee, dried fruit, brown spice, white pepper, and wood polish flavors. Finishes with a chewy tannic fade of rich spice and dried fruits. A big brawny style with fire and remarkable balance. Opens and smooth out great with water.

Shot 8 Neat 16 Rocks 20

### Old Forester

Pretty amber color. Toasted meringue, dried fruit and brown spice aromas. A rich entry leads to a zesty, dry-yet-fruity medium body of rich peppery brown spice, vanilla, and buttery toffeed nuts and a long spicy fade. Very nice.

Shot 3 Neat 6 Rocks 8

### Basil Haydens

Light amber color. Sweet corn, toffee, nuts and charred wood aromas have a lean edge. Round, vibrant entry leads to a dry medium-to full-bodied palate with somewhat lean oak, corn, and caramel flavors. Finishes with a warm wave of toffee, spice, and drying wood.

Shot 6 Neat 12 Rocks 17

### Jim Beam Black

Deep amber color. Vibrant aromas of peanut brittle, chestnut, creamy vanilla, spice, and toasted grain. A smooth, supple entry leads to an oily dry-yet-fruity medium-full body of honeyed cornbread, brown spices, and toffee. Finishes with a long robust fade of nuts, caramel, white pepper, and minerals. A smooth and flavorful bourbon for every application.

Shot 4 Neat 8 Rocks 11

### Four Roses Single Barrel

Deep amber color. Intense aromas of vanilla toffee, caramelized nuts, coconut cream, and spice. A round, vibrant entry leads to a dry-yet-fruity full body of sweet cinnamon, honeyed raisin toast, white pepper, praline, and mineral flavors. Finishes with a long, evolving fade of nuts, clove, and wet stones. Great intensity and poise.

### Templeton Rye

Deep amber copper color. Dense and intense aromas of cinnamon bark, mincemeat, cashew butter, milk chocolate, and peppery spice. A soft, silky entry leads to a dryish medium-to-full body of creamy vanilla custard, cola nut, spicy caramelized nuts, and honeyed rye toast flavors. Finishes with a long sweet grain, peppery spice, and white ash fade. A fun, flavorful rye.
